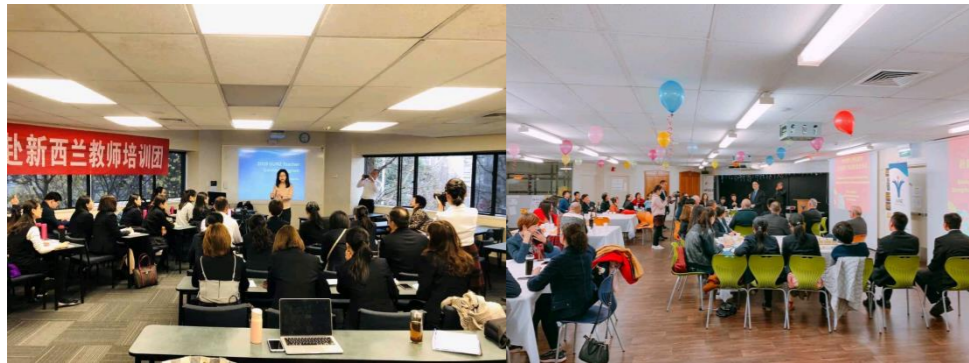


UUNZ NEWSLETTER
